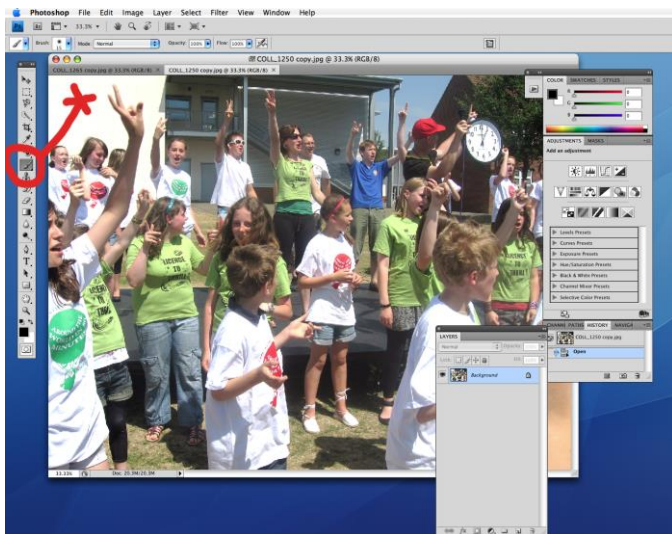


# Making a Baldessari style image in Photoshop

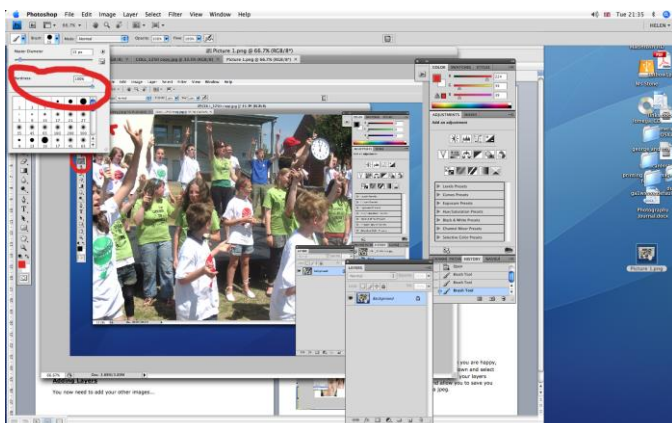


## Start

Open the file in Photoshop. Crop and alter contrast and brightness for the image and any other changes you need to make.



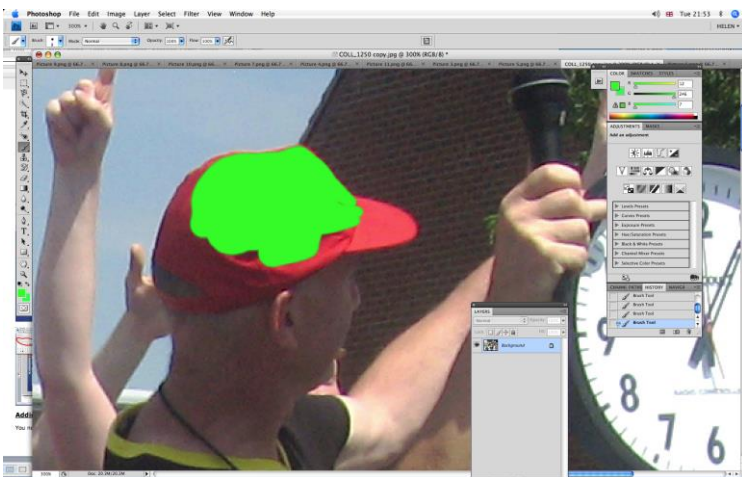
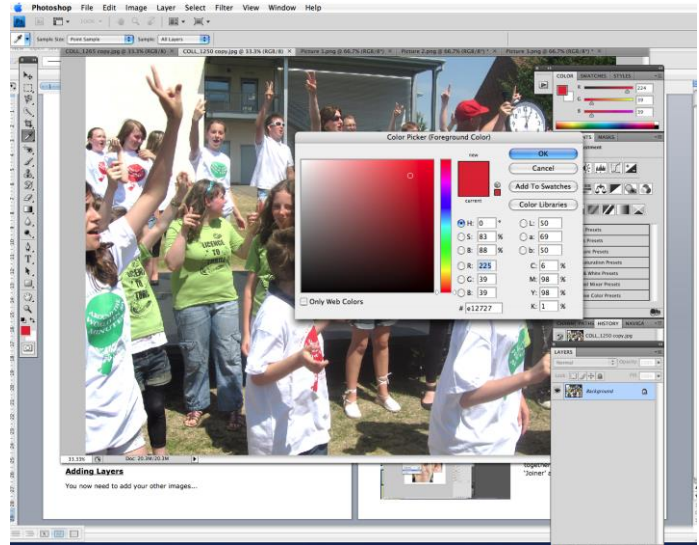
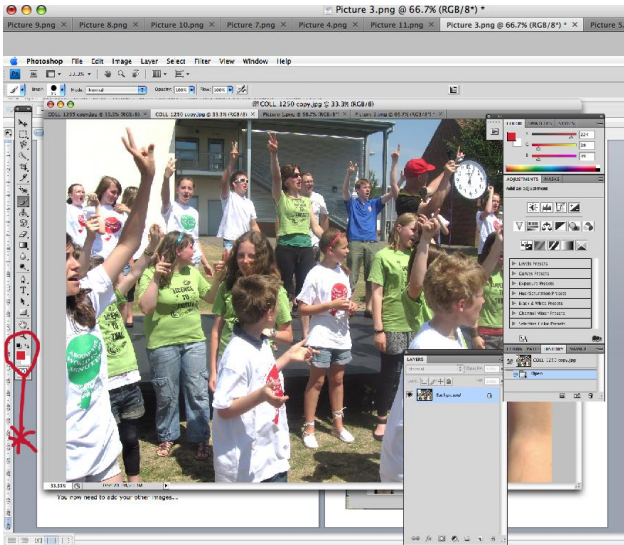
Choose the brush tool from the left hand tool bar, make smaller or bigger with the [ ] **keys** located next to the P key.



Give the tool 100% hardness by dragging the cursor over to the right hand side.

# Adding Colour

To alter the colour, select the colour tool at the bottom of the tool bar, located on the left hand side. Then pick your new colour then press **OK**.



**Zoom** in and apply your colour. Keep changing the tool size depending on what you are adding colour to. Be careful what you colour, some things will look better than others. Don't forget to make print screens as you go along. You can also add dots to the faces



Now save your final image into the M drive, in your area, in your file and call it your **SURNAME** with Baldessari after. Send the final image and print screens to the print folder for your teacher to print.

Ensure you put your name in the header so your teacher knows whom the work belongs to!
