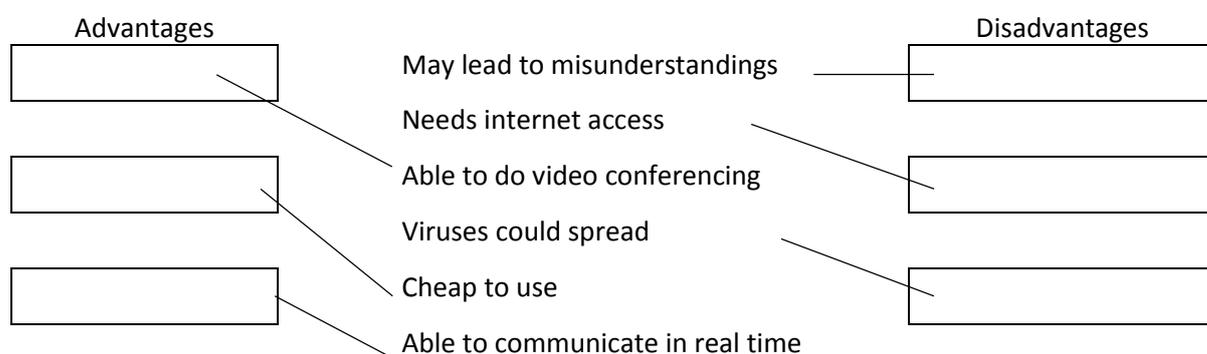

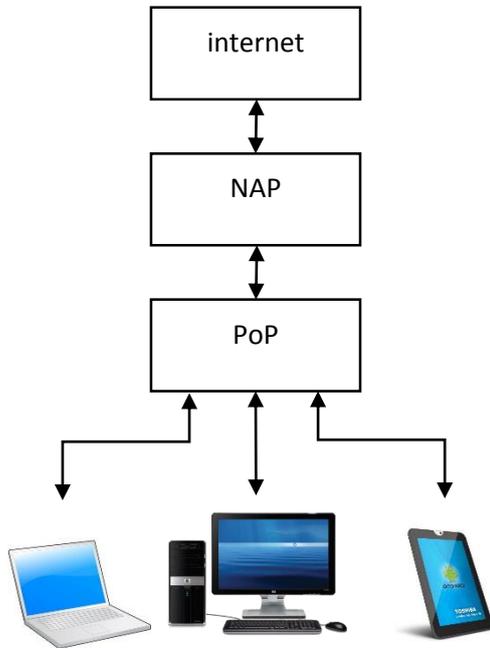

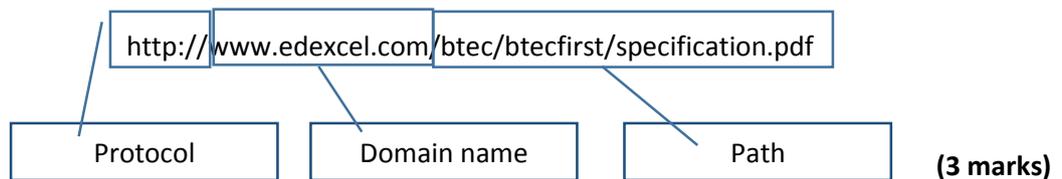

20. Strange email address, misspelt word, request for pin number.
21. Email is sent by the sender client to the email server. It is 'stored' there until the recipient client requests access and then the email is 'forwarded' to their computer.
22. Packet switching is used for data sent across a network such as the internet. Data is prepared for transmission by being broken into packets with information such as source and destination and error checking. The packets are sent over the network separately and by different routes. They are then reassembled and checked at the other end.

Device	Transmission Mode	Explanation
Control system on a production line	Half-duplex	Signals go in both directions to monitor and send instructions. They do not need to go at the same time.

Mouse connecting to a computer	Simplex	Signal go in one direction at a time
Smart phone synching to a computer	Full-duplex	Signals go in both directions at the same time.
