Young Person's Travel Pass

As you are no doubt aware, to assist parents with the cost of bus travel and to promote sustainable travel, Kent County Council provide its Young Person's Travel Pass scheme. The pass provides subsidised bus travel at school times for all secondary aged students living in Kent for a cost of £290 (in 2018/19).

Applications for the new academic year can be made from **4th June**. To be sure of having a pass for the start of term, applicants need to have applied by **Friday 13th July** and as such we would urge you to apply by this date to avoid disappointment.
