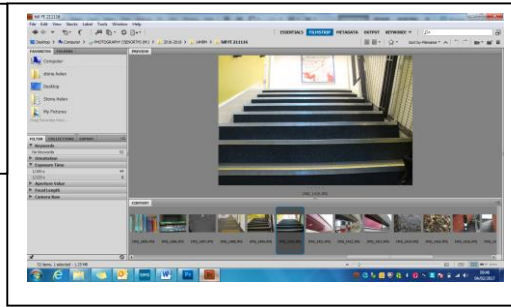
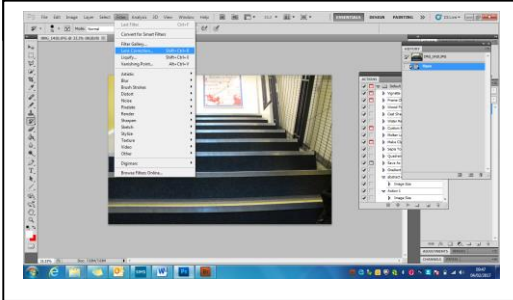


# Using Lens Correction in Photoshop-good for correcting digital camera faults

1. Open an image in Photoshop using Bridge, double click to open

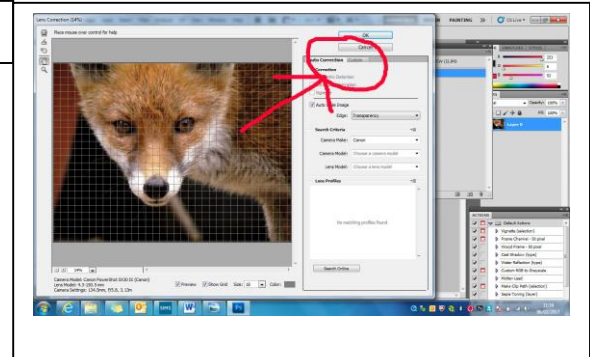


2. Go to the tool. Filter – lens correction

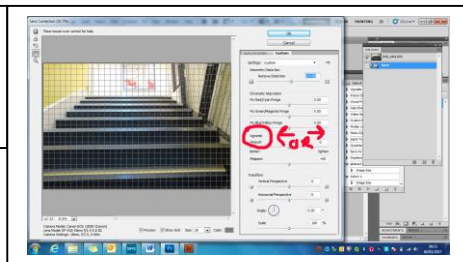


3. Cancel the next command which is... **Update Lens Profiles Database Cache**

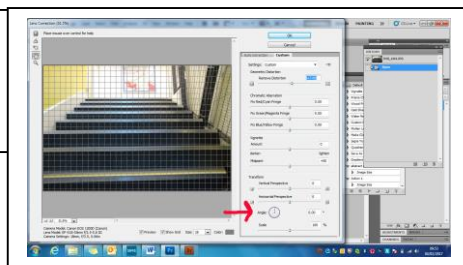
4. Then go to custom



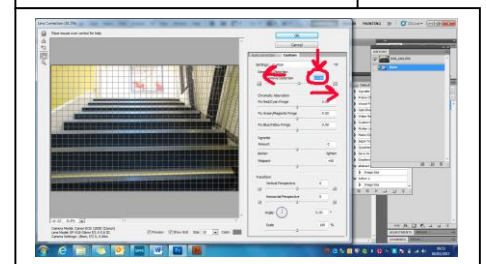
5. Here you can add dark corners with Vignette



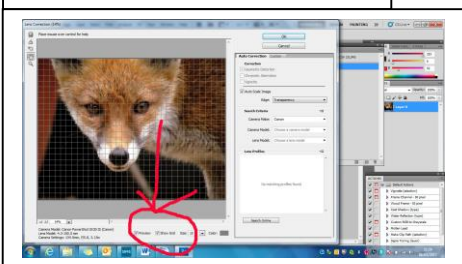
5. Or change the angle
